

## How can I be notified when new articles are posted to the “Director’s Chair” or be notified when new topics are posted to a “Forum”?

If you would like to be notified when a new article is posted to the “Directors Chair,” you have two options.

1. Set a “Watch Forum” on the ECE-SOS: General Announcements” forum

How to Steps:

- a. Go to the "ECE-SOS Announcements" forum



On the right hand side, just below the topics listed, there is a link labeled "Watch Forum."

Click the link. It will toggle to “Unwatch Forum” and e-mails will be sent to you, when new posts are made to the forum. Since the “ECE-SOS: General Announcements forum is used to announce new articles posted to the "Director's Chair", or some new feature added to the ECE-SOS web site and any of it's resources, you will receive e-mail notices of these activities.

The "Watch Forum" link can be used in each individual forum that you wish to monitor for new posts. Just go the forum that you want to watch and click the link. When you wish to stop receiving e-mails for a specific forum, just click the to “Unwatch Forum” link associated with the Forum

2. Subscribing to a RSS feed is a simple way of being notified of Web site updates. If, you have an RSS Reader or a browser that has this feature, You can us the “Feed” feature of the “Director’s Chair” section of the site.
